56th Session of the UN Commission on the Status of Women and Related Events

Many members of the Division, UNA-USA members from around the country, and thousands from the U.S. and countries around the world participated in meetings of the Commission and side events hosted by dozens or organizations. In an unusually frank statement at the end of the Session, Michelle Batchelet, UN Women Executive Director, expressed disappointment at the outcome, which fell short of delegates adopting consensus on "agreed conclusions" on the priority theme of rural women and girls.
