Visit to the Science Barge, Yonkers, NY Saturday, September 15, 3 pm

What?

The UNA-SNY Division's Energy Project invites you to join us for a visit to a one-of-a-kind prototype sustainable urban farm, the Science Barge in Yonkers, NY.

Solar panels, wind turbines, and biofuels generate all of the energy needed to power the barge. Rainwater and purified river water irrigate the hydroponic greenhouse. The barge thus operates completely "off the grid." Those who wish to may join us afterwards for some refreshment and discussion at the nearby Dolphin Restaurant.

Where?

The Science Barge is located at 99 Dock Street in Yonkers, NY and is easily accessible by car and mass transit. From the Yonkers MetroNorth station, exit on the land side of the tracks on Buena Vista Ave. Turn left and then left again on Dock Street. The Science Barge is at the end of Dock Street, about 300 feet away. Street parking is available. There is also a municipal garage at the corner of Buena Vista Ave
