Before joining UNA-USA, Chris Whatley served as Deputy Executive Director and Washington Office Director of The Council of State Governments where he served as a voice for U.S. states in Washington, D.C. and oversaw the Council's federal advocacy and international outreach. He began his career as a field-based program officer for the International Republican Institute running democracy assistance projects in Liberia, Nigeria, South Africa, and Zimbabwe. Whatley holds a B.A. in Government from Angelo State University and an M.S. in Foreign Service from Georgetown University.

Announcing "The World I Want" Video Contest for 6th to 12th Grades

We are happy to announce **"The World I Want" Video Contes**t, open now. Please share this with your local schools, teachers, and others you may know!

High school and middle school students (Grades 6-12) are invited to create videos that aim to illustrate their ideas of how the world should be and incorporate UN values, such as

the importance of humanitarian aid, equal rights and global peace that demonstrate how the UN, as a whole or through one of its programs, provides inspiration to the people of the world today.

We will select six winners: a first, second and third place awardee for high school students and a first, second and third place awardee for middle school students. Each first place winner will receive the grand prize of a private tour of the United Nations Headquarters in New York City by a UNA Southern New York State Division board member, and receive the award at the UNA-USA Young Professionals benefit dinner in December as a special guest. Winners will receive a gift of \$250 for 1st place, \$150 for 2nd place and \$75 for 3rd place. Arrangements will be made to invite all winners to other Division or Chapter events where they will receive their prizes. All winners will have their videos displayed on the UNA Southern New York State Division website. All entrants will receive a certificate of participation.

Eligibility: Students who live or go to school in the five boroughs of New York City and the following counties are eligible: Columbia, Dutchess, Greene, Nassau, Orange, Putnam, Rockland, Suffolk, Sullivan, Ulster and Westchester.

UNA-USA and the United Nations Foundation are partnering with the UN to help lead U.S. consultations on the **Post-2015 Development Agenda**. The Southern New York State Division is one of ten UNA chapters or divisions across the country that will lead a consultation. We are planning to hold ours in early November, and will announce the date soon. More information will be send soon in a newsletter. The Division's Energy Project is already planning a roundtable on energy.

"Citizen engagement and consultation are key to the success of international development agendas; Americans can be excited about this process and be involved," said UN Foundation President & CEO Kathy Calvin, who announced the news at UNA-USA's Annual Meeting on Capitol Hill in Washington, DC. "UNA-USA members now have an important opportunity to engage their communities in supporting the UN as it builds on the legacy of the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) and works toward a more equitable, prosperous, and sustainable world."

Post-2015 Development Agenda consultations are taking place in countries all over the globe, including online at www.worldwewant2015.org, to engage as many people as possible in the process of formulating developments targets to end poverty. These consultations bring together perspectives of civil society, the private sector, global citizens and other stakeholders to further progress on the existing MDGs and plan for strategies for poverty alleviation, global health, and education, and the

environment after the year 2015.


